4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be mild irritation at the site of contact.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

Skin contact: Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water.

Ingestion: Wash out mouth with water. If conscious, give half a litre of water to drink immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.
